Course Title:	BTEC Level 3 Certificate in Dementia Care
Overview:	As the number of people with dementia increases, it is important that the adult social care workforce has the skills needed to meet their needs. This qualification's aim is to enhance practice around the care and support of people with dementia and it has been developed in partnership with The Alzheimer's Society and other sector experts to reflect current best practice in this area.
Course Content:	The Edexcel BTEC Level 3 Certificate in Dementia Care is an 21 credit qualification that consists of four mandatory units and a choice of optional units. The Mandatory Units are: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Understand the Process and Experience of Dementia- Enable Rights and Choices of Individuals with Dementia whilst Minimising Risks- Understand and Enable Interaction and Communication with Individuals who have Dementia- Equality, Diversity and Inclusion in Dementia Care Practice.
Methods Used:	This qualification is knowledge based and the learner will be required to complete an Assignment which includes: Research, questions, reflective accounts, work products and professional discussion
